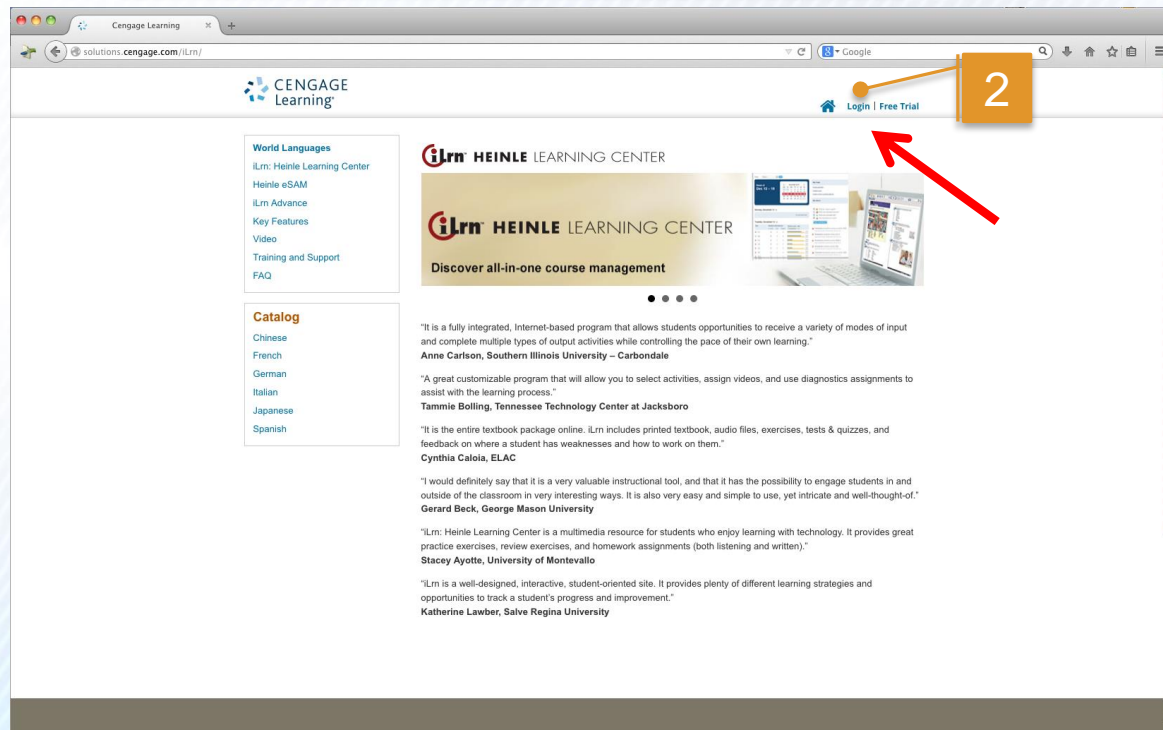

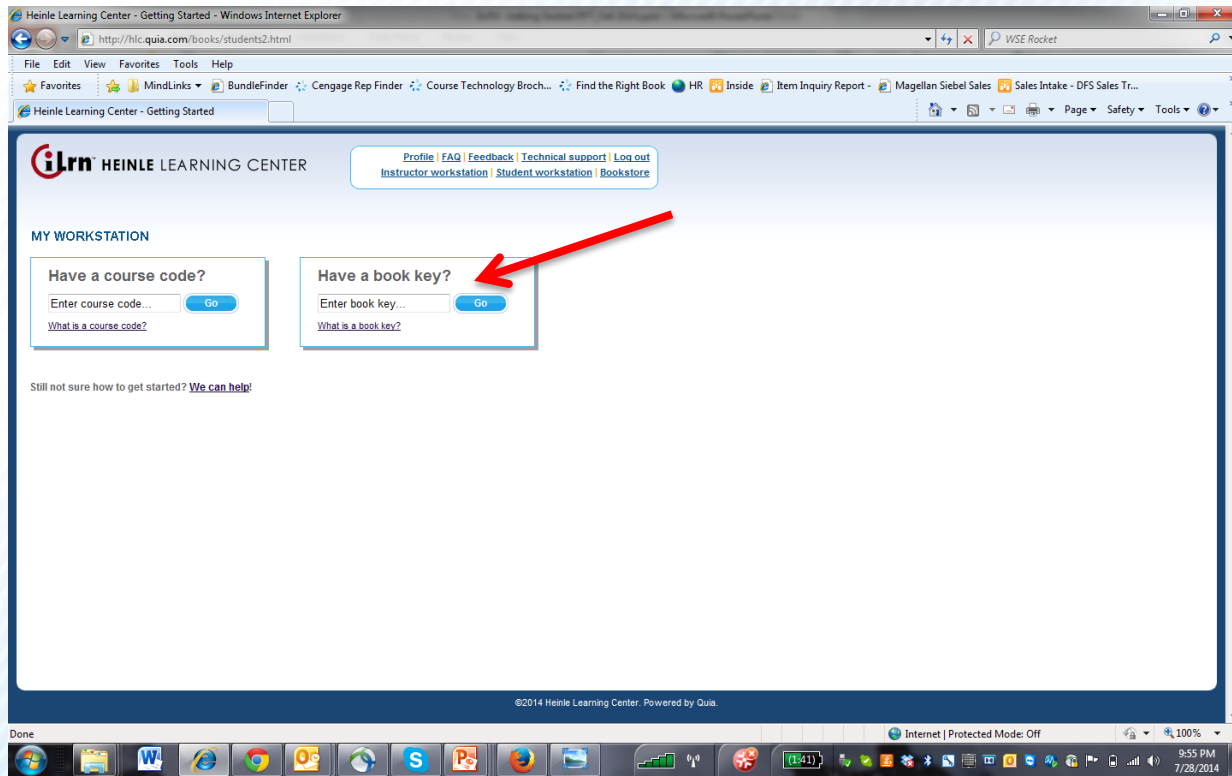
Create your Username and Password

A. If you are a first time user, you will need to choose a username and password in order to create your account (you will not complete this process if you are a returning user).

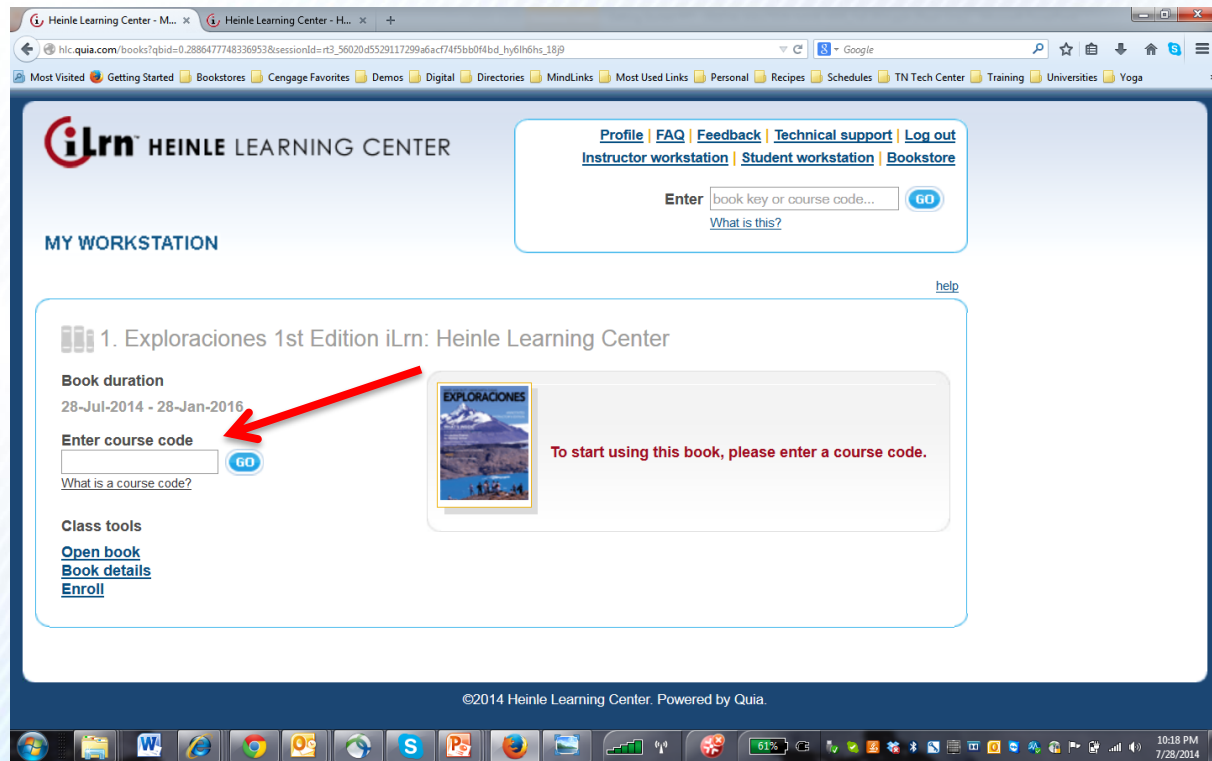
